Governor's Office for New Americans hosts New American Voices discussion focused on education alongside key community leaders

LAS VEGAS, NV – The <u>Nevada Governor's Office for New Americans (ONA)</u> hosted a discussion focused on education alongside key community leaders in the Grant Sawyer State Office Building in Las Vegas.

Launched in June 2022, the New American Voices initiative aims to provide a voice and a seat at the table for Nevada's directly impacted communities, stakeholder groups, and state partners through monthly discussions addressing the needs of Nevada's immigrant and refugee communities.

"The input provided here today highlighted many of the educational needs and challenges faced by our students and families in Nevada's immigrant and refugee communities, that we must address," said Charina de Asis,

Executive Director of the Governor's Office for New Americans. "We aim to turn today's discussion points into actionable items and collectively find solutions for them alongside our federal, state, & local partners."

Discussion points at today's meeting included but were not limited to: Cultural competency training for educational professionals, further support of English Language Learner (ELL) programs, bridging the technical divide, reinforcing the K-12 to higher education pipeline, and expanding workforce pathways.
