LANGUAGE ACCESS POLICY

Policy: # 06-2022

Effective: 10/20/22

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to define the Language Access Policy of the Agency for Nuclear Projects (the “Agency”) and the guidelines and rules under which it will operate. One of the agency’s missions is to provide public information about the proposed commercial storage of spent nuclear fuel at Yucca Mountain Nevada. It is, therefore, essential that the public documents are accessible by the public.

AUTHORITY & REFERENCES

The legal basis for this policy is SB318.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all printed and digital products prepared for public release by the Agency.

POLICY

It is the policy of the Agency to ensure the printed and digital products prepared for public release by the Agency are accessible by the members of the public.

PROFILE OF AGENCY LEP CLIENTS

The Agency’s clients include the state’s population. The Agency will provide documents in English and Spanish.

LANGAUGE ACCESS SERVICES AND PROCEDURES

The Agency will provide documents in English and Spanish. Documents will be prepared so they are compatible with accessibility software so they can be accessible to visually impaired people.

IMPLEMENTING AGENCY LANGUAGE ACCESS SERVICES

This policy will be implemented by producing printed documents in English and Spanish. Digital documents will be compatible with accessibility software.

EVALUATION OF AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR AGENCY ACCESS PLAN

The effectiveness of the policy will be reviewed by the staff annually and the success of the program will be included as a performance criteria for the agency in its annual performance survey.

This policy is not a substitute for relevant law or regulation, nor does it establish additional

rights beyond those provided in law and regulation. This policy is intended to be used in conjunction with State law and the Nevada State Administrative Manual (SAM).
